











- ◆ THE OLD BALL GAME: Frequently a sellout for its home-base San Diego Padres and Seattle Mariners, 12,339-seat Peoria Sports Complex has upgraded its fan-pampering surrounds with fixed and shaded seating, better viewing, souvenir shopping and expanded socializing areas.
- ◆ PRO TIP: Before opting for the All-You-Can-Eat Deck ticket upgrade (\$20) and ordering from the copious menu of craft beers, stake out Autograph Alley near the right-field concourse to snare photos and autographs from your favorite players.
- PERFECT STAY: Peoria is the northernmost of the Valley's baseball stadiums, making The Boulders Resort & Spa in nearby Carefree the go-to for luxelevel overnights. The AAA Four Diamond property just completed an eight-month, multi-milliondollar renovation that included total bedroom-to-bathroom transformations to the 160 guest casitas, plus a fully revamped main lodge that offers new restaurant dining, enhanced group facilities and a revamped waterfall-over-boulders pool complex. theboulders.com
- ◆PLAY: Golfers are further spoiled by The Boulders' exceptional 36-hole semi-private facility designed by Jay Morrish, with top-rated Quintero (Rees Jones) and Trilogy (Gary Panks) golf clubs nearby. For spectacular off-property dining, feast at innovative Brian's Black Mountain Barbecue or the James Beard-lauded Chef Kevin Binkley's Restaurant in nearby Cave Creek.
