



BOULDERS RESORT & SPA

The Boulders Resort & Spa is an extraordinary desert hideaway.

Located on some 1,300 acres in the Sonoran Desert foothills of Carefree, Ariz., just north of Scottsdale, the site is named for the dramatic, awe-inspiring

Jay Morrish designed both golf courses, the North in 1985 and the South in 1991, and each offers an unmatched bounty of magnificent desert panoramas. The resort's signature hole is the fifth on the South, where the green is carved from a



12 million-year-old granite boulder formations that serve as a focal point of the landscape.

In addition to an endless array of first-class amenities at the resort — six restaurants, a lounge, four swimming pools, eight tennis courts and a 33,000-square-foot spa — the two golf courses have won some of the industry's highest accolades to make the Boulders one of the country's most acclaimed destinations.

The Boulders Golf Academy offers an opportunity for private, one-on-one instruction from an accredited staff, including Donald Crawley, one of the top 100 instructors in the country.

The resort's exquisite and innovative architecture blends with the surrounding desert landscape as 160 guest Casitas and 61

Villas, from one, two, and three bedrooms each, are grouped in low-rise clusters. Blended seamlessly from the Sonoran Desert, the resort has won some of the travel and tourism industry's highest accolades. The Casitas, many of which are situated to offer golf course views, blend with the Boulders' iconic architecture with sand-colored, adobe-style buildings. The Villas and Haciendas offer the space of exclusivity of a grand vacation home as guests enjoy the comforts of a fully equipped and beautifully styled kitchen, fireplaces, flat-screen televisions, high-speed Internet and doorstep parking and private entrances.

With several options combining to provide some 25,000 square feet of meeting space, the Boulders is capable of handling business functions, conferences and special events of any size. The Tohono Conference Center includes a 5,400-square-foot ballroom, with asymmetrical walls that appear to be carved out of stone, and expansive windows overlooking the lush Sonoran desert.

LOCATION

The Boulders Resort & Spa is located in Carefree, Arizona, just north of Scottsdale.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The resort has 160 newly renovated Casitas, many of which are located along the golf course. The Villas are one-, two-, and three-bedrooms and range from 1,800 to 3,000 square feet. The Haciendas are beautiful, fully equipped luxury accommodations ranging from 3,000 to 3,200 square feet. MEETINGS

The Tohono Conference Center is 12,000 square feet with a 5,400-square-foot ballroom overlooking the desert. The Sonoran Ballroom offers 2,000 square feet of ballroom, meeting rooms and terraces for special functions. The new Latilla Ballroom is 5,500 square feet with breathtaking views. The Boulders Club has a variety of boardrooms, and there are a number of outdoor event spaces.
