Three Arizona regional breweries took top honors at the 2016 World Beer Cup, one of the most prestigious beer competitions in the world. Four Peaks Brewing Co. of Tempe received a gold medal for Kilt Lifter, its Scottish-Style Ale. Chandler-based San Tan Brewing Co. won a silver medal in the Fruit Wheat Beer category for its Mr. Pineapple wheat ale. Flagstaff's Lumberyard Brewing Co. took home bronze in the American-Style Pale Ale category with its Knotty Pine Pale Ale.
